





Have lunch at one of several restaurants. Your return trip will be over Mount Rose highway stopping at a breathtaking vista of Lake Tahoe. Depending on time and everyone's interest the tour can return directly to Montbleu or continue on around the North and West Shore of Lake Tahoe. Approximately 130 miles round trip.




## Guided Tour to Truckee

Truckee is a place rich in history with a quaint downtown that hosts charming shops and superb restaurants set in authentic historic buildings. Recently listed on the National Register of Historic Places, Truckee proudly retains its historic roots. It was named for a Paiute Indian chief who helped guide thousands of emigrants in their westward journey through a 40-mile desert. Truckee is well known for its logging, ice manufacturing, the Emigrant Trail, as well as for the tragic expedition of the Donner Party. You can discover much more about their captivating story at Donner Memorial State Park museum and Pioneer Monument. Half the fun is driving there because of the superb scenery along the way, and other half is walking around old town to browse the shops and have lunch. The trip will be counter-clockwise around the Lake. Stops are planned along the way. Driving directions and tour information will be provided at the beginning of the tour. Distance is about 100 miles round-trip.



### Around the Lake

### Squaw Valley


Enroute from South Lake Tahoe to Truckee (west side of the Lake) there is a turnoff to Squaw Valley—a ski resort and site of the 1960 winter Olympics. During the summer you can ride the aerial tram to High Camp at an elevation of 8,200 feet for breathtaking views of the valley and Lake Tahoe. If you have time, you can play golf, hike, walk through Squaw Village, and just enjoy the ambiance. Squaw Village is 40 miles from the Montbleu Resort.

### Hope Valley Loop

This tour proceeds west on Highway 50 from the Montbleu, then left on Highway 89 before leaving the Lake Tahoe Basin. This takes you over Luther Pass (7,740 feet), followed by descent into the Hope Valley. From there you head north on Highway 88 into Genoa and return over Highway 207 (Kingsbury Grade). This is a relatively short trip with magnificent scenery—approximately 60 miles.

### Placerville, CA

Placerville is a charming California gold rush town named after the placer gold deposits found in its river beds and hills in the late 1840's. After the discovery of gold in nearby Coloma, CA by James Marshall in 1848 sparked the California gold rush, the small town now known as Placerville was known as Dry Diggin's after the manner in which the miners moved cartloads of dry soil to running water to separate the gold from the soil. The name was changed in 1854 when the City of Placerville was incorporated. It has numerous buildings listed in the National Register of Historic Places, and an *old town*. Placerville is 75 miles one-way from the Montbleu Resort—a drive of approximately 1.5 hours. Some winery stops along the way are listed.

Turn left out of Montbleu and go 3.9 miles. Car wash is on the left. Two bays, \$2 for standard time.

## Edgin Coin Op Car Wash

2281 Lake Tahoe Blvd.

Turn left out of Montbleu and go 4.7 miles. Car wash is on the right. Three bays, \$2 for standard time.
